 - mothers, grandmothers, sisters, daughters, nieces, aunts, or 1st cousins
- Retroactive- email with names and national numbers
 - legacy@dar.org



Membership

Prospective Member Database (PMD)

Prospective Member who requests to join the Society through the National Website

- Membership Chair sends email with the meeting times of the chapters in her area (25 mile radius)
- When prospective member chooses a chapter then she is assigned to the chapter
- Email sent to Chapter Regent, Treasurer and Registrar
- Prospective Member appears in Chapter PMD

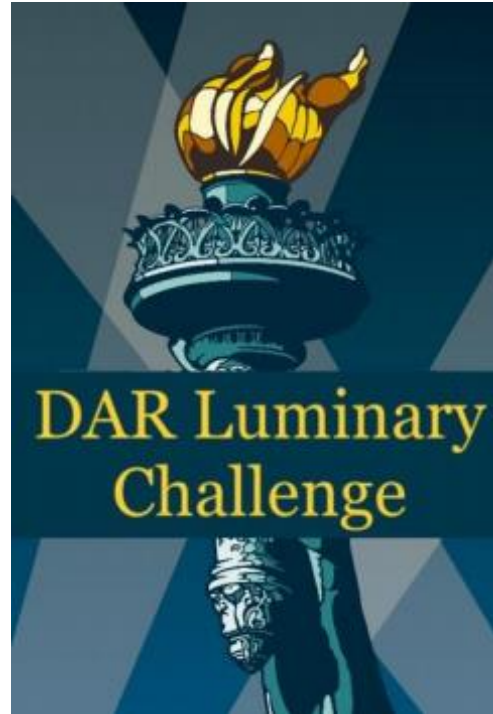

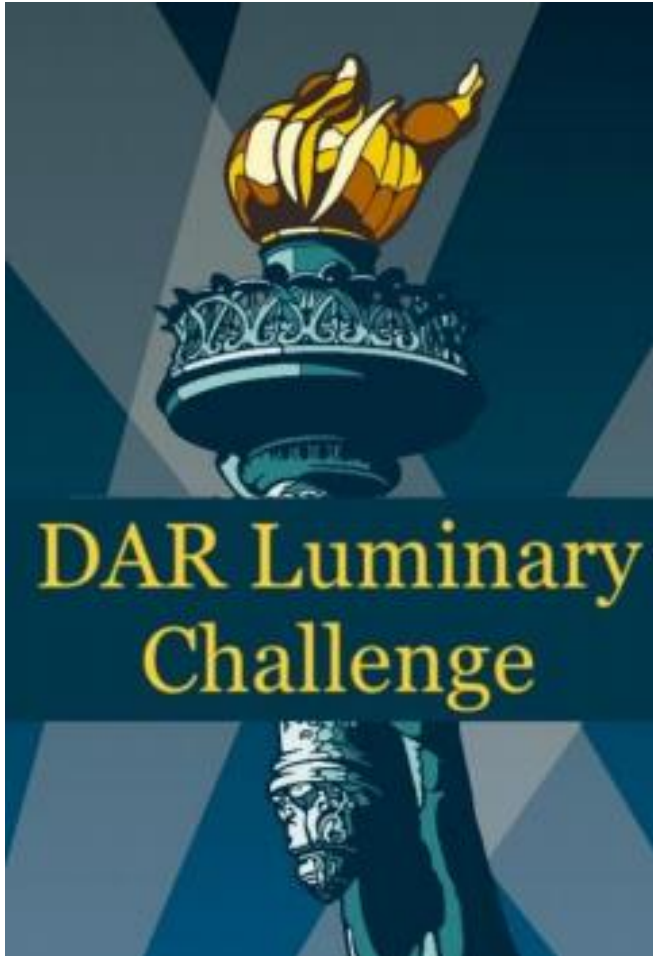

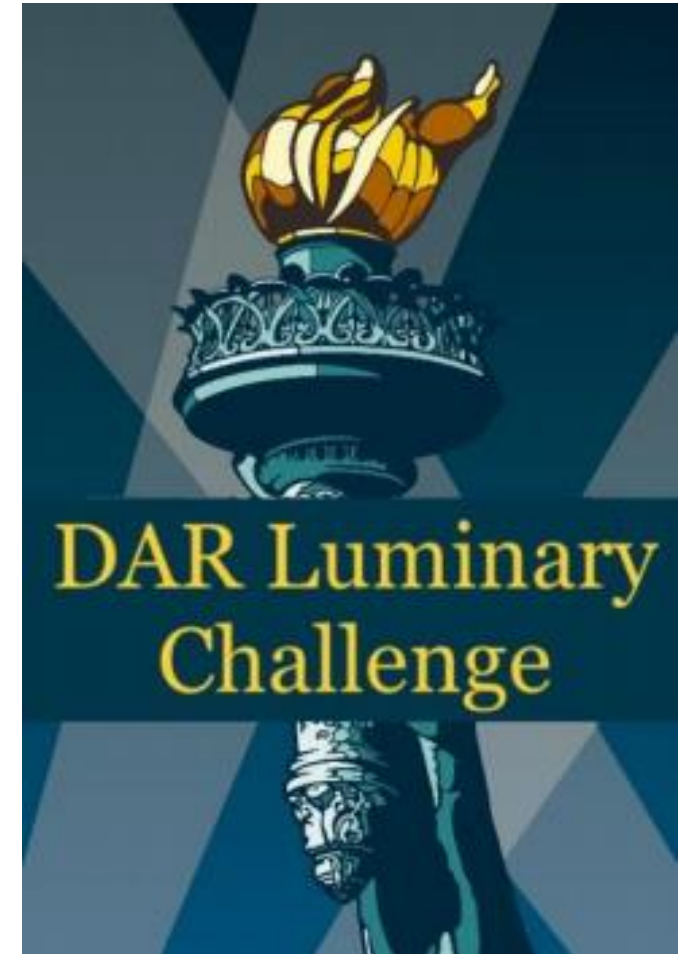

Membership Pins

Member-For-Member Pin



Every member has an opportunity to share her commitment to NSDAR by promoting membership through the Member-for- Member Program.

- To be eligible for member-for-member credit, a member must identify and invite a prospective member to the chapter, and her information must be entered correctly on page 1 of the new member application.

- Once the new member's application is verified and her national number is assigned, the new member's chapter regent or registrar is responsible for applying credits. Members grayed out are those whose applications were received before March 1, 2016, and they are entered by the OSG staff from the application. Member for Member credit will not be given until it is entered by the chapter regent or registrar or the OSG office.

- Once the Member-for-Member (M4M) credit is applied by the chapter regent or registrar or the OSG office, the member receiving credit will be able to order the pin.



Life Membership Pin

Life membership is a great way to make certain that DAR membership remains intact throughout a member's lifetime! Upon becoming a life member, this pin may be purchased to wear on the official DAR ribbon.



Junior Pin

Any DAR member who joined between the ages of 18 and 35 may purchase a Junior pin to wear on the official DAR ribbon. She may continue to wear this pin throughout her life to signify that she joined DAR as a Junior.
