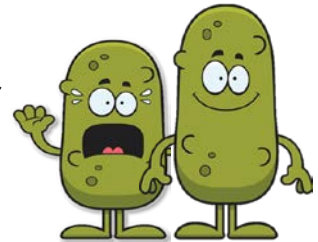
BYLAWS AND THE “PANDEMIC PICKLE”

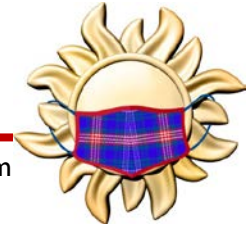
